CAROLYN MEADOWS

Carolyn Dodgen Meadows is president of the National Rifle Association of America. An experienced political leader and activist, Meadows was elected to the National Rifle Association Board of Directors in 2003 and is a Benefactor member in the Association. She serves as Chairman of the Meeting Site Selection Committee and Vice Chairman of the Legislative Policy Committee. Meadows is also a member of the International Affairs Subcommittee and the Audit, Finance, Public Affairs, and Executive Committees.

Meadows has worked on or managed dozens of county, state and national political campaigns, including campaigns for Ronald Reagan, George H.W. Bush and Bob Dole. She was an RNC National Committeewoman from Georgia and served as a National Convention delegate in 1992, 1996, 2000, 2004, 2008 and 2016. She is a member of the Advisory Committee for Republicans Abroad and has lectured in Paris, Rome and London.

She is also the Second Vice Chairman of the American Conservative Union (ACU) Board and member of the American Conservative Union Foundation and the Council for National Policy (CNP) Boards. Meadows was appointed by the governor of Georgia to serve as Chair of the Stone Mountain Memorial Association Board.

Mrs. Meadows grew up in a family active in hunting and competitive shooting. She attended Georgia State University and later worked for Lockheed Martin, where she organized hunter and gun safety courses for the employees. Meadows spent time in Australia shortly after drastic gun control measures were enacted there, an experience which drove home for her the pressing need to protect our Second Amendment rights through legislative and social action. She and her husband Bob reside in Marietta, Ga. They have three married sons and seven grandchildren.





CHARLES COTTON

Charles Cotton is the first vice president of the National Rifle Association of America. First elected to the NRA Board of Directors in 2001, Mr. Cotton is a Benefactor member in the Association. He is currently Chairman of the Audit and Pistol Committees, and Vice Chairman of the Bylaws & Resolutions and Meeting Site Selection Committees. Mr. Cotton also serves as a member of the Legal Affairs, Legislative Policy, Finance, Competition Rules & Programs, and Executive Committees, and is a Trustee of the NRA Civil Rights Defense Fund.

Mr. Cotton is a civil trial attorney and partner with the Cotton-Farrell law firm. A strong advocate for the Second Amendment and law-abiding gun owners, Mr. Cotton has been promoting, drafting, and supporting pro-gun legislation in the state of Texas for over three decades. He was instrumental in the passage of the original Concealed Handgun License bill, range protection legislation, the Motorist Protection Act, and Castle Doctrine in the Lone Star State. Mr. Cotton is an NRA Certified Instructor and a Texas License to Carry (LTC) Instructor. He is frequently interviewed by radio, TV, and newspaper reporters concerning firearms, self-defense laws, and constitutional protections. Mr. Cotton has taken numerous tactical firearms courses at Thunder Ranch, and is a competitive shooter, hunter, and collector. A Life member of the Texas State Rifle Association (TSRA), he was the recipient of the 2006 TSRA Presidential Citation Award.



WILLES K. LEE

LtCol (ret) Willes Lee is second vice president of the National Rifle Association of America and member of the Board of Directors. Willes manages several programs and serves on eight NRA committees including as Chairman of the Outreach, Military and Veterans' Affairs, and Education and Training Committees. He is a Life member of NRA, Second Amendment Foundation (2017 Defender of Liberty recipient), Gun Owners of America, and a Co-Chairman of the Trump-Pence Second Amendment Coalition.

Lee is President of the National Federation of Republican Assemblies, on the ACU Foundation Board (CPAC hosts), and a former RNC member/State Chairman. Col Lee is a combat veteran graduate of West Point, a 22-year Ranger and Airborne qualified Armor officer, DSSM/BSM/LM.

GNAT SHOOTING USA

the ultimate shotgun game

GNAT:

A radio-controlled airplane that you shoot with real shotguns, real shells, real excitement!

What is a Gnat? Basically, it's an airplane just like the ones the military use for target practice, but much smaller and specifically designed to be shot at with shotguns. Imagine it. After a session of shooting conventional clays, a nippy little target plane comes zipping by from the right, shows a flash of belly as it jinks and pulls up into a steep climbing turn. The guns bark and a hit from an ace shot sets off a pyrotechnic charge onboard the aircraft. A huge cheer goes up as the guns reload for another teasing pass, followed by another and another until either the time is up, or the unfortunate target is downed by the sheer fire power.

Once you have shot at the Gnats, plain old clays will seem a little dull.

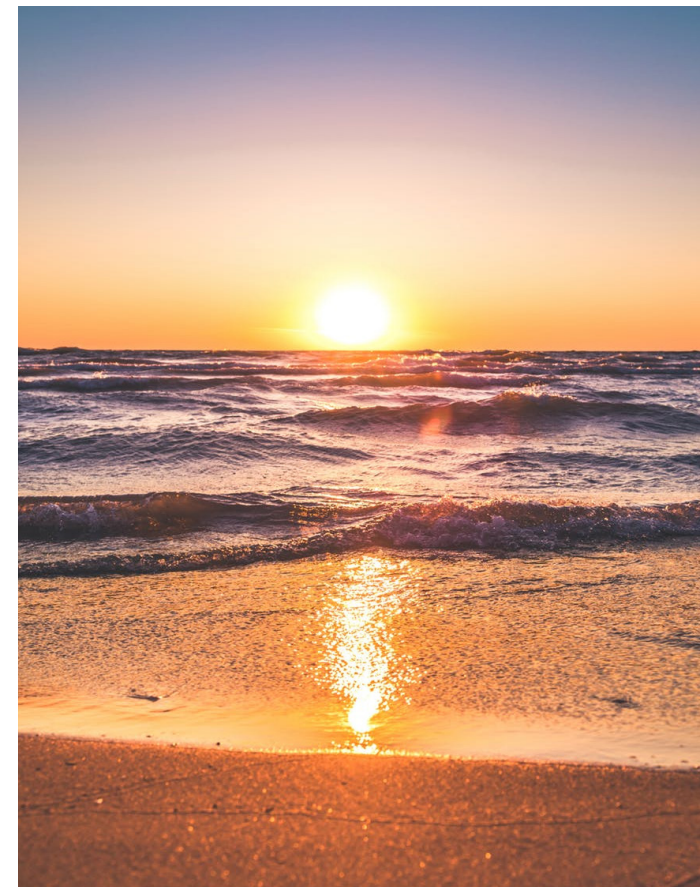

These are rare and original pieces with great care made by their owners to keep them in firing condition.

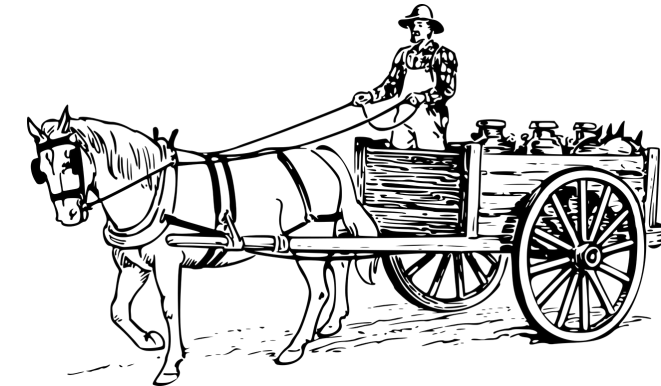

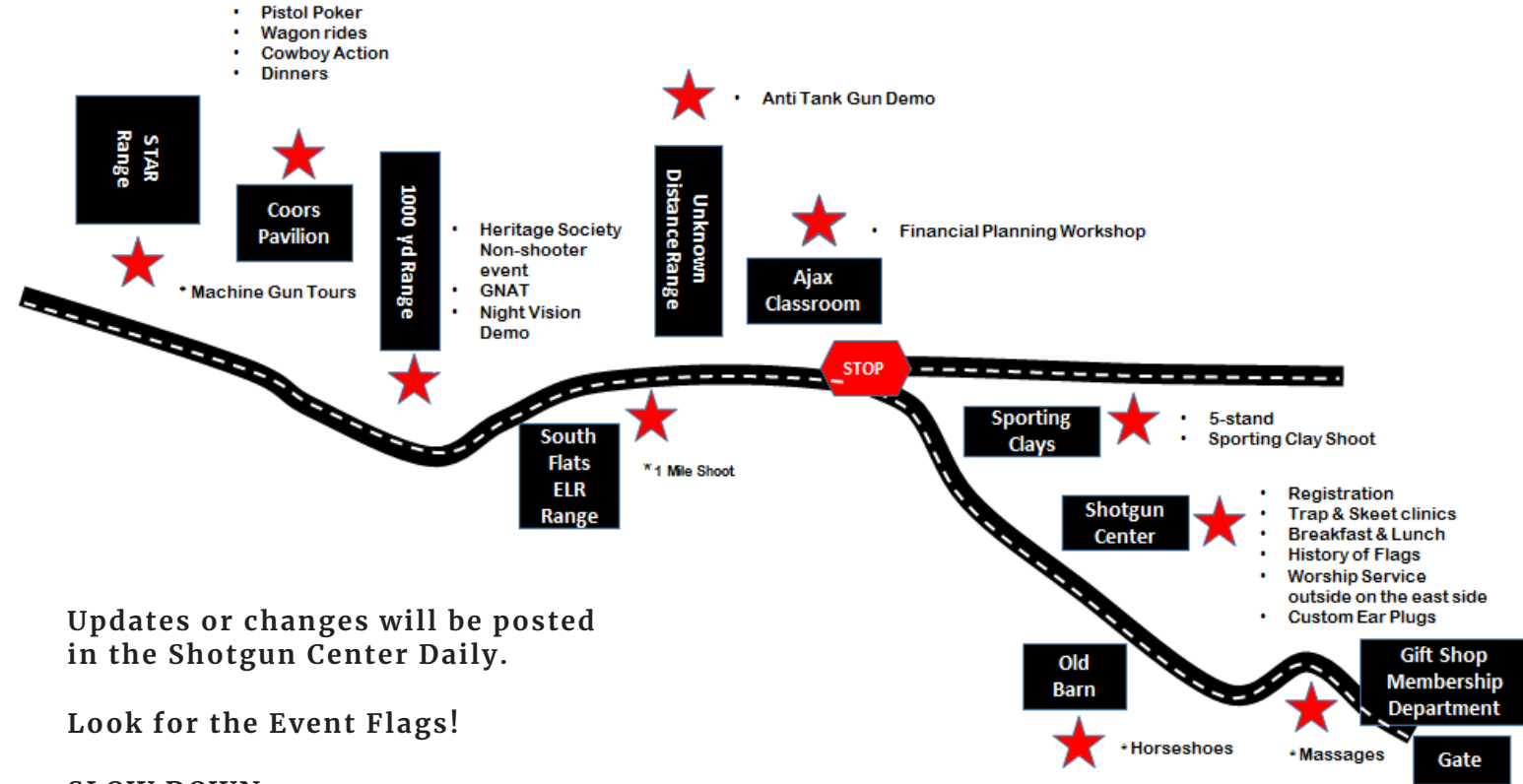
